Planned Giving

The act of making a commitment to give a charitable organization a major gift over time or at death, as part of the donor's overall estate and financial planning.

How to Get Started

The definition of an endowment:
A fund maintained in perpetuity to provide an income stream to an organization.

- A bequest made through a donor's will, living trust or beneficiary designation form and retirement accounts.
- Make a life income gift to FB4K through a :
Charitable Remainder Trust
Charitable Gift Annuity
Charitable Remainder Unitrust
- Assets remaining at the termination of the trust or gift annuity may be directed to our permanent endowment fund at WLCF to support Food Backpack for Kids.

Additions to the Endowment Fund may be added to at any time by making a check payable to WLCF with an indication of the name of the fund (FB4K)
